

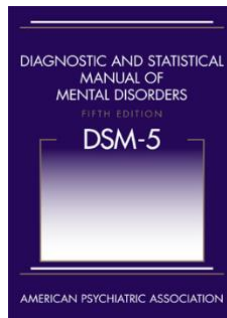

- [JSTOR](#) [RRCC Library Access] – peer-reviewed articles in many fields including the social sciences and psychology
- [PubMed](#) [RRCC Library Access] – citations for biomedical literature from MEDLINE including literature on psychiatry and journals in various areas of psychology
- [ERIC](#) [RRCC Library Access] – articles and reports about education, maintained by the US Dept. of Ed. – check the “full text” box for complete articles
- [Campbell Cooperation](#) [Online Public Access] - systematic reviews in the social and human sciences that help inform policy

The field of Psychology adheres to the APA style for citations and formatting.

APA In-text citation example:

Ellis (2017) explains the basics of how rational emotive behavior therapy works, “It encourages self-effort and the resulting experience of greater empowerment so that clients can rightly claim to take responsibility for, and create, their emotions” (p. 272).

APA Bibliographic/End-of-text citation example for an academic article:

Ellis, D. J. (2017). Rational emotive behavior therapy and individual psychology. *Journal Of Individual Psychology*, 73(4), 272-282.
