LIT 222 British Lit Since 1770 (3 credits).

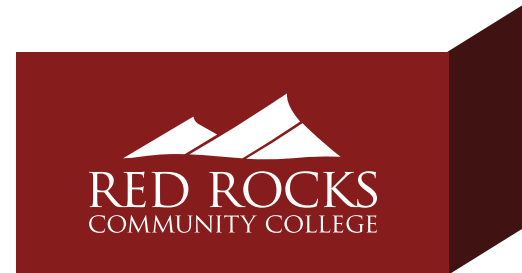
You must enroll in both classes for the Spring semester. Classes meet on Tuesday evenings 5:30-7:30 in the Spring semester.
