HPR 178 <i>Spring Enrollment</i>	<p>Medical Terminology</p> <p>High School Instructor: Theresa Lazzeri</p> <p>Introduces the structure of medical terms with emphasis on combining and using the most common prefixes, roots, and suffixes. It includes terms related to clinical laboratory, diagnostic imaging, nuclear medicine, and oncology as well as major body systems. Classroom structure provides accepted pronunciation of terms and relative use in the health care setting.</p> <p>Prerequisite (one of the following): ACT Scores: English 18 SAT Scores: Verbal 470 Accuplacer Scores: Sentence Skills 95 High School Class Exemption: 3.0 un-weighted high school GPA and passed H.S.
