CPR FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

Course Information:

This class follows the 2015 American Heart Association Guidelines for CPR.

The class is Video Driven

Guided skill practice in CPR and AED use

25 question open book Written Evaluation requiring a score of 84% or better, with 3 attempts to pass.

Objectives:

Through skill practice and written evaluation the student will:

Demonstrate an ability to recognize a cardiac emergency and respond appropriately.

Demonstrate an ability to perform adequate compressions and ventilations on an unresponsive adult, child or infant; one or two rescuers.

Demonstrate an ability to recognize and handle a choking emergency.

Airway Management with pocket mask and Bag Valve Mask

Automated External Defibrillator (AED) use

Course Completion Requirements:

Purchase or have access to the AHA BLS Healthcare Provider Manual

Participate in the entire class by:

Viewing & performing skills demonstrated on video

Participate in all class activities

Demonstrate to instructor competency in performing all required skills listed in course objectives.

Pass written test with a grade of 84% or better (AHA requirement)
