Lisa Fowler Updates:

- EAB visiting campus June 1st. Everyone is welcome to the Open Session 9:45-10:30.
 - Lisa, Linda Comeaux, Bryan Bryant and Michele Haney spent 5.5 hours in a

budget meeting establishing priorities and scrutinizing open jobs. Positions that

help attract students will be filled:

- Accessibility Services, Rec Center, and Call Center positions will be filled.
- Catalog software was approved, \$8,600. Have been working with an older, unsupported version.
- Go2Orientation was approved to purchase the whole suite, but because of dollar amount it needs to go through the purchasing bid process this fall.
 - We are still in about a two million dollar budget shortfall
 - Travel will be evaluated as needed if part of a grant or for retention or accreditation
 - Bryan will present the budget to the RRCC Board
- June 21st will be our planning retreat with a focus on retention and HLC upcoming visit and our 2018-2019 goals
- We are switching over to an electronic Student Feedback form, which is live on most Student Services pages, with a Burgundy button that says "Tell us How We're Doing" Here's a link: <u>https://rrcc.formstack.com/forms/student_feedback</u>
 - We would like to have a kiosk on each campus to allow students fill out the

feedback forms. Exploratory process with IT.

- 203 signed up to walk
- CDHE legislation passed favorable to Community Colleges
 - PLA will transfer among all institutions
 - They can't make up their own rules at the 4 year institutions, the Degrees with Designation will be accepted as written
- Still waiting on missing grades. 770 were missing on Monday, due date was Sunday. 109 still missing on Wednesday. Linda Comeaux is keeping a close eye on this.

Jean Kelly – Accessibility Services

- Working with ACC on a pilot project to find systems/products to jointly purchase to help automate or streamline some of the processes in Accessibility Services.
- Jean conducted a Faculty a & Student survey this spring 2018 semester, (also Fall 2017)
 The goal was to help determine if we are actually removing barriers for students with
 disabilities which is our overarching mission. From both students and faculty we were
 asking questions related to the ease of getting accommodations in place and whether
 these accommodations truly removed the barriers students were facing due to their
 disability. In general terms, the accommodation process is working with room for growth.
- 6 students in the PA program have accommodations
- With the construction, the space from a closet previously in Jean's office will be utilized to create an accessible private testing room
- Stacy Roe is traveling to India with the RRCC group
- Will be hiring a full-time Navigator/Office Specialist position instead of having 2 parttime. Working with HR on that job description
- Jean will be helping with interpreting for the keynote speakers at the Service Learning conference. Also will be hiring extra interpreters
- The first Annual Fox Trot relay was held on 5.15.18 with 6 teams. The New Kits on the Block won first place and the Ravenous Unicorns won Team Spirit.

Glenn Holly – Career Services

- Recently attended a Career Services Roundtable. Currently there is no connection between the 13 Community Colleges for electronic job boards. As a group they are looking for bids and demos to provide a consortium where if a job posts to one school, it could post to all.
- Very interested in Purple Briefcase, which is owned by Noel Levitz. It has an Internship module included for less money the current system in use with GradLeaders, previously known as CSO.
 - In final stages of approval at VP meeting
 - Meet with IT for single sign-in, which signs all of our students up at once
 - Great for employers to list at all schools
- Strategic Plan from ILEARN, doing pre an post student surveys on Career Assessments

- We have resources in the Student Resource Guide...will get posted on the website for easy access
- Credit Completion Process
- Who does what kind of surveys or reports?
 - Dean pulls end-of-semester report for Students on Probation or Suspension
 - Dean checks for pre-reqs every week
 - Jean has done Faculty & Student Surveys Fall 2017 & Spring 2018
 - Kirk does Student Surveys- last in May 2018
 - Kirk monitors usage of the SRC
 - Glenn does weekly reports
 - Financial Aid pulls SAP reports every semester
 - Jen does Climate Surveys every other year
 - Linda does International Student exit survey: Mar, May, July, Oct & Dec
 - Linda also tracks student success: May, July & Dec

- Linda monitors full-time enrollment and absenteeism
- Linda has weekly co-curricular activity
- Gina collects evaluations from large group tours
- Receive results of robo-call campaigns in Jan and Aug
- Every manager/director does monthly report for each program area
