



## High School Senior Achievement Scholarship Application

**Deadline: December 1, 2017**

The High School Senior Achievement Scholarship is for the high school student who has completed all of their high school graduation requirements by December of their senior year and wants a jump-start on their college education. This scholarship requires 6 to 12 credit hours of enrollment during each of the following three semesters: Spring 2018, Fall 2018, and Spring 2019.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Early graduation completion requirements by December 2017
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Colorado resident for tuition, as determined by the College
- Application for Admission to Red Rocks Community College
- Be a U.S. citizen/eligible non-citizen

### **Additional Guidelines**

**The scholarship application form along with the following information must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office by December 1, 2017**

- Short essay (minimum of 100 words), typed, 12-point font
- Statement from high school counselor verifying completion of high school graduation requirements by December on school letterhead, signed by counselor.
- Copy of high school transcript

The scholarship will cover up to 12 college credits (tuition only) for three semesters (Spring 2018, Fall 2018, and Spring 2019). Registration fees, course fees, books and other educational expenses associated with the college courses are the responsibility of the student. Summer semester is optional with approval from the Financial Aid Office.

### **Registration Information**

**The following enrollment steps must be complete, prior to registering for classes:**

- Submit an Application for Admission and sign up for the College Opportunity Fund online at [www.rrcc.edu/onlineenroll/](http://www.rrcc.edu/onlineenroll/)
- Complete the Assessment Process: provide ACT or SAT test scores or take the ACCUPLACER assessment at RRCC.
- Meet with an Academic Advisor for course planning. Advising is available on a walk-in basis or by appointment Monday-Thursday 8:00-5:30 and Friday 9:00-4:30. You can call (303) 914-6255 to schedule an appointment with an advisor.
