

Important Dates for Student Employment – Summer 2023

Date	Significant Event
May 21	Final day of spring student employment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All student employment is terminated as of this date - Work-study employees who are not continuing at RRCC after spring may not work after May 9th
May 22	First day of summer semester student employment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All new and returning students must be registered for six credit hours in the summer academic semester to be eligible for student employment - Student employees registered for fall semester courses only (without summer registration) will be required to contribute to a TIAA IRA. - Beginning of summer semester work-study eligibility. Students must have a minimum of 6 credit hours, as well as work-study eligibility, in spring, summer, and fall semesters. - Contact the Financial Aid Office for details – 303.914.6256 or rrcc.financialaid@rrcc.edu
May 29	Memorial Day <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No Classes, both campuses closed
May 15-25	Semester Interim <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student employees may work up to 28 hours per week - Check with your org owner before increasing student workloads
May 30	All student employees must return to 20 hours per week
May 30	Summer Semester begins
June 8	Course Drop Cutoff date – Last day to drop 8- and 9-week classes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Last day to initiate a tuition refund - Tuition is due. Late fees begin accruing June 9
June 19	JUNETEENTH - Both Campuses Closed
July 4	Independence Day Holiday – Both Campuses Closed
July 5	HR begins accepting fall semester renewal and new hire forms
July 25	End of 8-week summer session
July 31	End of summer semester student employment
August 1	Beginning of fall semester student employment
August 2	End of 9-week summer session
August 3 - 22	Semester Interim <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student employees may work up to 28 hours per week Check with your org owner before increasing student workloads
