



ASCENT

The ASCENT program is a 5th year high school option for students who earned college credit (at least 12 credits) through Concurrent Enrollment. Students must meet eligibility requirements and be selected by their school district to participate in ASCENT.

| <p>STEP 1: MEET WITH ADVISOR AND/OR WT INSTRUCTOR</p> <p>Meet with an academic advisor to discuss academic pathway and establish 5th year ASCENT Plan (example on 2nd page).</p> <p>Continuing Warren Tech students: will meet with WT instructors first to determine what WT courses will be taken during ASCENT year (fall/spring semester). Then will meet with a RRCC advisor to plan general education courses if AAS degree seeking.</p> | <p>STEP 2: SUBMIT 5TH YEAR ASCENT PLAN TO SCHOOL DISTRICT</p> <p>Students will then submit their established 5th year plans to their school district ASCENT coordinators.</p> <p><i>Please note: students are not officially selected for the ASCENT program until May.</i></p> <p>Students can enroll in courses before acceptance, but will be responsible for all tuition/fees.</p> | <p>STEP 3: MEET WITH C.E. Advising Guidelines

- Must be enrolled full-time (12 credits) each fall and spring semester.
- 12-15 credit max per semester covered. No exceptions.
- No online classes - only traditional tuition covered by the district (In-person, Remote, Hybrid & Hyflex)
- Full term classes only. No accelerated/late start classes.
- Must be degree or certificate seeking. Only degree/certificate applicable courses allowed.
- Not allowed to take developmental classes. Needs to meet English and Math requirements for degree.
- Students may be eligible to retake a course for grade replacement.
- Not financial aid (FAFSA/Institutional scholarship) eligible. Private scholarships allowed.
- Students must visit with the Concurrent Enrollment Office to submit ASCENT Agreement each semester.
- ASCENT registration holds will be placed. Schedule changes with must be approved by C.E. Office.
- WT students will meet with Kristin Uhland in Admissions to register and then visit with the C.E. Office to submit ASCENT paperwork.
- Only continuing WarrenTech students allowed to enroll in WT classes. Must continue on same pathway started in high school/Concurrent Enrollment.
