

- Go to the Red Rocks homepage www.rrcc.edu
- Click on the "Apply" link at the top of the page
- Click the "APPLY NOW" button Apply Now
- Click the "APPLY NOW" button
- Click on "CREATE ACCOUNT"
- Enter your personal information to create a profile
- Select Spring 2020 as your Anticipated Entry Term
- Create a Username and Password. <u>Write the information</u> <u>down for future use.</u>
- Click "Create Account"
- Once in your account/profile scroll down to "Next Steps" and click on: 2. "Start an Application"
