- Click on "The Rock" link
- Enter your RRCC Student ID Number: **S**_
- Enter your Password. Your default password is: StudentMMDDYYYY (the word 'Student', followed by your date of birth)

Print your RRCC class schedule

- Once logged into "The Rock"
- Click on the "Student" Tab
- In Registration Tools, click on "Detailed Student Schedule (with drop-withdrawal dates")
- Select your Term
- Print your class schedule

Know the drop and withdraw dates

Last day to Drop: _______ If classes are dropped before or on the "Drop Date" you will not be charged tuition and fees for your courses. No record of the course is will appear on your transcript.

Last day to Withdraw: ______If you withdraw before or on the "Withdraw Date" you will be charged 100% for the course. A "W" grade will appear on your transcript (will not impact your GPA but may have future financial aid/completion rate implications).
