Responsibilities:

- To meet qualifications and maintain essential institutional standards for courses, programs, services, or activities.
- To self-identify as an individual with a disability to Accessibility Services in a timely manner if requesting accommodations and to obtain information, as needed.
- To follow operational procedures for requesting accommodations each semester.
- To present the “Letter of Accommodation(s)” to your instructor(s) in a timely fashion.
- To contact an Accessibility Services staff member if reasonable accommodations are not implemented in a timely manner.
- To read and follow the behavioral expectations outlined in the Student Code of Conduct (found in the Student Handbook).
- To register complaints and concerns with the proper individuals in the stated sequence: your service provider, the Director of Accessibility Services, and then the Vice President of Student Success.
