## **Job Summary:**

The Campus Safety Specialist has an important role at the Red Rocks Community College and serves as an integral function to the Red Rocks Community College Police Department. It is entrusted with the assignment of upholding and enforcing the rules and regulations enacted by the college administration, and serving the campus community through dedication and commitment in public safety to create a safe learning environment.

## **Job Description:**

The main responsibilities of this position include:

- Patrolling campus on foot
- Enforce parking violations
- Monitoring and responding to requests for security services
- Reporting criminal acts and emergencies to RRCC police personnel or Lakewood Police Department if RRCC police is not available
- Assist RRCC police in the event of emergencies, critical events, accidents involving injury and property damage, evidence collecting and processing, etc.
- Responding to Arvada Campus for evening lock up
- Complete written statements when necessary
- Additional duties as assigned by dispatch, the patrol supervisor, or sergeant

**Note:** Campus Safety Specialists are unarmed. Discretion and sound judgement by all personnel should be used when determining if the call for service is safe for an independent response from a Security Officer.
