

Important Dates for Student Employment – Fall 2020

Date	Significant Event
July 31	Final day of summer student employment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All student employment is terminated as of this date
August 1	First day of fall semester student employment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All new and returning students must be registered for six credit hours in the fall academic semester to be eligible for student employment
August 1 – 14	Semester Interim <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student employees may work up to 28 hours per week - Check with your org owner before increasing student workloads
August 15	All student employees must return to 20 hours per week
August 17	15 week classes begin
Sep 5 – 7	Labor Day Weekend <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No Classes, both campuses closed - No student or hourly work without pre-authorization
September 2	Drop Cutoff Date – Last day to drop 15 week classes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Last day to initiate a tuition refund - Tuition is due. Late fees begin accruing 09.03.20
October 20	All College Development Day – No Classes
November 23 – 29	Fall Break – No Classes
November 26	Thanksgiving Holiday – Both Campuses Closed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No student or hourly work without pre-authorization
November 23	Student hiring begins for spring semester <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HR begins accepting Renewal/New Hire requisitions for spring semester employees.
December 8	End of 15 week fall classes
December 8 – 18	Semester Interim <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student employees may work up to 28 hours per week - Check with your org owner before increasing student workloads
December 18	End of fall semester student employment
December 25 – Jan 1	Winter Holiday <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No Classes, both campuses closed - No student or hourly work without pre-authorization
