- Must be dressed appropriately (i.e. clean clothing without offensive labels, no open toed shoes).
- No use of offensive language, sexual or racist comments.
- Must be present during the entire shift.
- Must fulfill the requests of the shop manager that directly pertain to the job position.

You must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours for the semester in which you will be working to apply for this position.

Students who are hired as shop assistants have the opportunity to learn unique valuable skills regarding machine maintenance and repair, inventory management, chemical management and overall shop management.
