



Red Rocks Community College Basic EKG Interpretation Spring 2018



This course is designed to assist healthcare providers in the identification of basic cardiac arrhythmias, especially those that are life threatening. Specifically the course will cover lead placement and obtaining a tracing, electrophysiology of the heart, waveforms on the EKG, and rhythm interpretation. It is the recommended course for healthcare providers who are seeing patients with cardiac monitoring in place in either the hospital or pre-hospital setting. This includes EMTs who work on an ambulance, in an ER, or as a telemetry technician in a hospital. It is a required prerequisite for Paramedic school and essential to anyone who will be learning Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS)
