Your I-20 can only be issued after we have received sufficient documentation of available funds and payment of the application fee.

Your application will <u>not</u> be processed until your application fee has been paid.

It can take <u>at least four business days</u> to process your application after we receive it with all of the necessary supporting documents. Incomplete applications will <u>not</u> be processed.

An <u>additional</u> non-refundable \$75 fee will be required for each subsequent I-20.
