•Friday at Lakewood Clinic a Health Provider will be available from 9am to 4pm

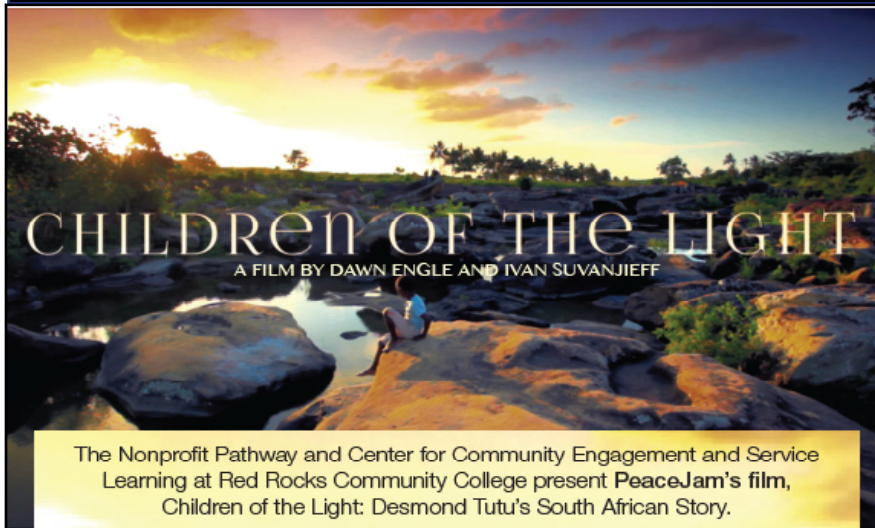
Hours and days are subject to change. This schedule is only for the months of August and September.
