Michael Kazin's important history of American pacifism is a compelling cautionary tale. His book, *War Against War*, is about the Americans who tried to stop their nation from fighting in one of history's most destructive wars and then were hounded by the government when they refused to back down. The anti war movement against the Great War ranks as one of the largest, most diverse, and most sophisticated peace coalitions up to that point in US history.

Emma Goldman: Anarchist
Portrayed by Sally Drucker

Emma Goldman was an anarchist and labor organizer known for her political activism, writing and speeches. In 1917, Goldman and a companion were sentenced to two years in jail for conspiring to "induce persons not to register" for the newly instated draft. After their release from prison, they were deported - along with hundreds of others - to the Soviet Union.

Eugene Debs: Socialist
Portrayed by James Walsh

Eugene Debs was an activist who worked in the labor movement in the early 1900s, traveling around the nation giving talks to workers, etc. In his outspoken views he suggested that wars are fought for the rich at the expense of the poor. His resistance to WWI ended with imprisonment under the Sedition and Espionage Act.
