The Arvada-Wheat Ridge Service Ambassadors for Youth (AWRSAY) program is a unique collaboration between service clubs, organizations, the cities of Arvada and Wheat Ridge, Jefferson County Public Schools, Red Rocks Community College and businesses in Arvada and Wheat Ridge. Since 2001 AWRSAY's mission is to facilitate change, ongoing recognition, educational and leadership opportunities for Arvada and Wheat Ridge youth who have overcome adversity.

We will honor middle and high school youth ages 13-19 who have demonstrated personal strength, resiliency and determination in overcoming adversity and making positive changes in their lives or in the lives of those with whom they come in contact. Example areas of overcoming adversity may be:

- Education/learning
- Personal
- Physical
- Emotional
- Social
- Academic

Youth must demonstrate consistent school attendance with a minimum of passing grades and a strong desire to learn. Youth from Arvada, Wheat Ridge and Edgewater area middle and high schools (public, private and home schooled) will be considered. Awards will include eight \$1400 (renewable: min. 6 credits with 2.5 GPA) and seven \$1200 (renewable: min. 6 credits with a 2.5 GPA) scholarships to Red Rocks Community College for high school seniors; monetary awards and community opportunities for youth middle school through grade 11 up to \$200 on a first-come, first –serve basis. All selected youth will be honored at our annual recognition ceremony.
