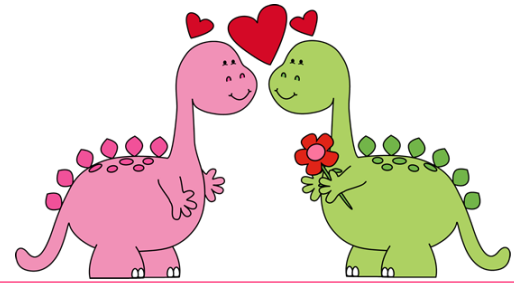
NEXT SCHOOL YEAR!
