- 2. Lookout Mountain Hiking Trails: It is a 0.8-mile loop. If you want to see wildlife, this is a great trail. You can stop at the Nature Center at Lookout Mountain, which is a great experience in itself.
- 3. Evergreen Lake Trail: It is a 1.3-mile loop. It is an excellent trail for kids to play and explore. There are places you can fish, rent boats, and have a beautiful family picnic.
- 4. Mount Falcon- Castle & Tower Hike: It is a 2-3 mile loop. There is a fire tower at Mt. Falcon that gives an incredible vies of Denver, Red Rocks, and the mountains.
- 5. Pine Valley Ranch Park Hike: It is a 1.2-3.2 Mile loop. There are several hiking options at Pine Valley Ranch Park. The park has a beautiful lake and a small island with a gazebo for the best family picnic.
