Did you know there are benefits to having your child enrolled in after-school care? Here are just a few.

1. Regular schedule and activity is maintained as kids are provided with different types activities at the same time each day.
2. Where kids get to spend time around one another in a supervised, structure and safe environment. Kids learn how to problem-solve, share and otherwise play and learn well together while their minds are still growing and personalities still emerging.
3. Child Care provides an opportunity for children to see other adults as mentors and authority figures able to provide them positive guidance.
4. An extensive study by the U.S National Institutes of Health has found young children have higher cognitive academic achievement scores as teenagers if they have spent in high-quality after-care as young children.
