# Parent Resource Center: Summer Break

# SUMMER REGISTRATION IS COMING SOON!

It might still be cold outside, but it's time to start thinking about flip flops, sunscreen and ... summer camp! Here are some common questions we get from parents:

## Where will camp be held?

# Our last day of care for the school year will be 5/22/18

Though the district is finalizing construction plans, we are hoping to hold camp at Kendallvue. We will keep you updated as we receive their final decision. The first day of summer camp will be May 28<sup>th</sup>.

## When can I register?

Summer registration will open as soon as possible once we hear from the district. I will send out an email as soon as I get a date. The registration forms will be posted to our website: <u>http://www.rrcc.edu/school-agechildcare/registration-forms</u>

## Do my children automatically have a spot since they were enrolled for the school year?

Summer registration is completely separate from the school year so all families interested in care need to submit a registration form. Our currently enrolled families have priority access, however at some point we do open registration up to everyone.

Spots fill up fast so we encourage you to sign up as soon as you can!

### Do I have to sign-up for every day?

No! When you register you select which days you need care. You can completely customize the schedule based around your family's needs and preferences.

### What will my kids do at camp?

We have the same high-quality programming during the summer as the school-year including a choice based schedule that incorporates STEAM projects, organized gym games, time to play outside as well as extras like wheels days and water days! We also go on field trips every Monday and Wednesday, and to the pool on Friday.

# Full Day / Registration Clarification

We do offer care over breaks and no contact days. These days are outside of your regular contract so you must sign-up for them separately.

Sign-ups are due two weeks in advance to secure the regular rate. Sign-up after that point is subject to the drop-in rate.

There are two steps to register:

1. Fill out the registration form to let us know that you are requesting care. Without this we cannot register your child, even if you make a payment towards that day. https://rrcc.formstack.com/forms/sacc

2. Make the required payment through CashNet, just like you do for tuition.

You can verify that your registration was processed by checking the print out on the parent table or asking a staff member.

# **Drop-In Registration Clarification**
