As a resource for families we have placed the Jeffco ballot initiative book highlighting 5A, 5B & Amendment 73 at the family center.

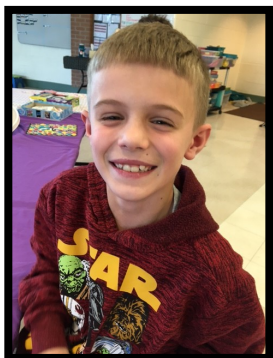
WINTER IS COMING...
