BAS degrees versus the BA/BS degrees. The main reason that community colleges can sometimes offer bachelor's degrees is when either the 4-year schools aren't offering the degree or when there is a need in the economy for those majors, such as the BSN degree that recently went through the legislature.

CSC degree (DwD) is being worked on by some of the CCCS schools. We don't offer the courses the way some of them are included on the degree plan, so it's likely that RRCC won't be included in that new transfer plan at this time.
