# Nadine Green - EAB Navigate Kickoff

- The Kiosk feature of Navigate is ready to launch. Financial Aid opened their kiosk today. There is a glitch with guest IDs, a workaround is in development.
- July 28<sup>th</sup> will be the rollout for non-students to use Navigate, but they can't sign in at the kiosk yet.
- Staff member can create a sign in that will not connect to Banner.
- After review, it appears Assessment does use SARS in a way that will be compatible with Navigate.
- First wave of CARE Units are all established. SARS goes away July 25th.
- Advising, Financial Aid, Accessibility, Assessment, Tutoring and Veteran's will be the first CARE units and kiosk users.
- Pat Bonich from IT has been very instrumental in helping this launch happen.
- NEXT steps are for everyone to develop their calendars/which Navigate will draw from Outlook and updates every 2 minutes.
- We will establish roles for security. EAB Roles are Advising, Faculty and Student. we will create roles for the front desk
- Shannon brings up the point to make notes in Banner, not just Navigate.
  Because Care unit notes will not be visible across units
  In the future we may be able to create roles that cross over units.
- Messages sent out through Navigate will need to be approved by Lisa Fowler.

# Lisa Fowler – VP Updates

Discuss CCCS Functional Groups. Each VP is assigned to interact with Functional Groups. Lisa Fowler is on the Statewide Accessibility Directors group.

Look at FTE for Fall. As of this meeting, ACC was the only metro CCCS college showing positive numbers. FRCC was down a little more than us.

Discussed the status of multiple open positions. They are not getting moved through HR very quickly and we do not reach back to applicants to let them know what is going on. We lose good candidates because the process takes so long.

Have Arnie come to SSLT to discuss positive suggestions and what job boards (Indeed, Andrew Hudson's, CC Weekly) we would like to see utilized. Faculty positions are posted on National Job Boards.

Jeffco Homeless count is happening county wide, volunteers will be going our into the community in groups to identify homeless. We will be helping to identify homeless students at both the Lakewood and Arvada campuses September 19-23. We will be using an Ipad, or paper copies...we need volunteers! Shannon and Steve are coordinating. There will be a training with tips on how to talk to people.

Action Center shelter is a go! We will start small:

- Hiding in Plain Sight scholarships can be applied to rent
- We will determine the number of credits a student must be taking to qualify
- No longer than 2 semesters
- Possible RA position offered to students
- Working on an MOU with HIPS
