



Red Rocks Community College EMT and AEMT Refresher Course Information



The EMT Refresher course at Red Rocks Community College follows the National EMS Education Standards for recertification of an (A)EMT certificate. It is approved by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. Completion of the course satisfies all requirements for recertification of a Colorado EMT certificate, and the requirements for National Registry EMT recertification.

Prerequisites:

- One of the following is required
 - Current, or less than 6 months expired, Colorado EMT certification
 - Current NREMT EMT certification
 - Proof of EMT course completion within the last two years
 - Confirmation from NREMT that a refresher course will [partially] meet the recertification requirements of an expired NREMT EMT certification. Co-requisites:

It is highly recommended that you take Biology 106 (BIO 106) during this semester if your goal is to complete either the Emergency Medical Technology degree, or the Fire and Emergency Services degree.

Registration:

Registration begins near the end of the preceding semester, generally early April and November. Students with all of the required pre-requisites are admitted to the program on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration is open enrollment and may be completed online. Program Cost:

Colorado resident tuition and fees for the EMR course are based upon 2 credits plus fees, approximately \$461. Costs for required textbooks and equipment are approximately \$200. Testing and certification costs for the National Registry of EMTs, after course completion, are approximately \$145. **All tuition and costs listed are approximate and subject to change.**
