

Red Rocks Community College Students Under 18 years of age



Students under the age of 18 are encouraged to take the Emergency Medical Responder course since the minimum age for certification at this level in the state of Colorado is 16 years of age.

Students under 18 are welcome to attend the classroom and lab portions of the Emergency Medical Technician program. However to complete the clinical rotations, which are required for successful program completion and eligibility for certification, the student must be at least 18 years old. In some cases this may mean the student has to wait until the following semester to complete the clinical rotations.

The minimum age to gain EMT certification in Colorado is 18 years old.
