



Customized Internship Assistance

The Experiential Learning and Internships Office provides customized internship assistance for interested students. To be eligible for **Customized Internship Assistance** you must attend a general **internship search meeting** with the Experiential Learning Coordinator, meet with a faculty member and complete a **Faculty Recommendation**, register with **Career Connect**, email copy of **resume** to Experiential Learning Coordinator, and complete the online **Internship Interest Form**. Once all items have been completed and verified you will be eligible to receive Customized Internship Assistance and will receive a welcome email with next steps.

Attend General Internship Search Meeting

Before requesting Customized Internship Assistance, you must have an initial meeting with the Experiential Learning Coordinator to talk about your resume as well as review the various resources and websites to use in your internship search. Schedule a meeting by emailing melissa.english@rrcc.edu.

Faculty Recommendation

Meet with a faculty member in your area and have them complete the **Faculty Recommendation**. Register with Career Connect. Career Connect allows you to search and apply for internships 24/7 with organizations interested in RRCC students. Career Connect has the most up-to-date information on available internships and will provide you with information about each internship as well as specific instructions on how to apply. Access Career Connect by logging in to **The Rock** and look for the **Career Connect** button on your **Dashboard tab** (at the bottom of the page) or visit: www.rrcc.edu/career-connect.
